Requirements

- Passport
- Proof of Language Skills: **English – IELTS or TOEFL**
- German – only required for courses taught in German
- **Two years of working experience** in a relevant field
- A convincing subject-related and personal **motivation letter**
- Most recent university degree obtained in the **last six years** prior to the application for the scholarship.
- Personally signed and dated full **curriculum vitae** (please use the sample europass form)
- One letter of recommendation, signed and (ideally) recently dated by your last employer (if applicable).

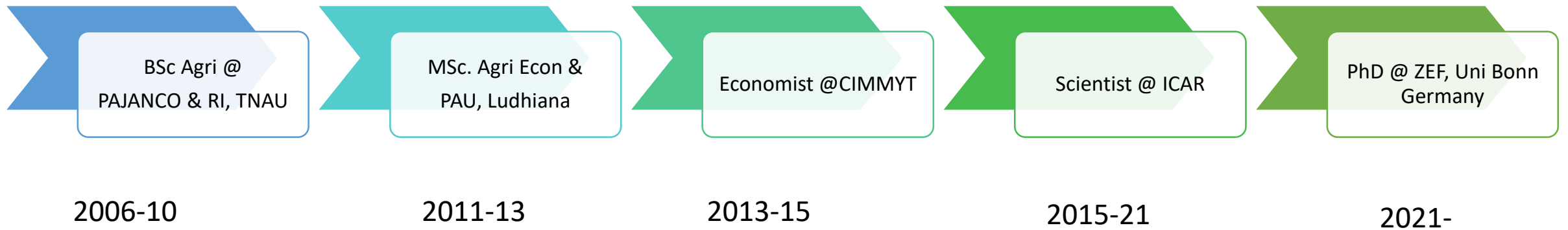

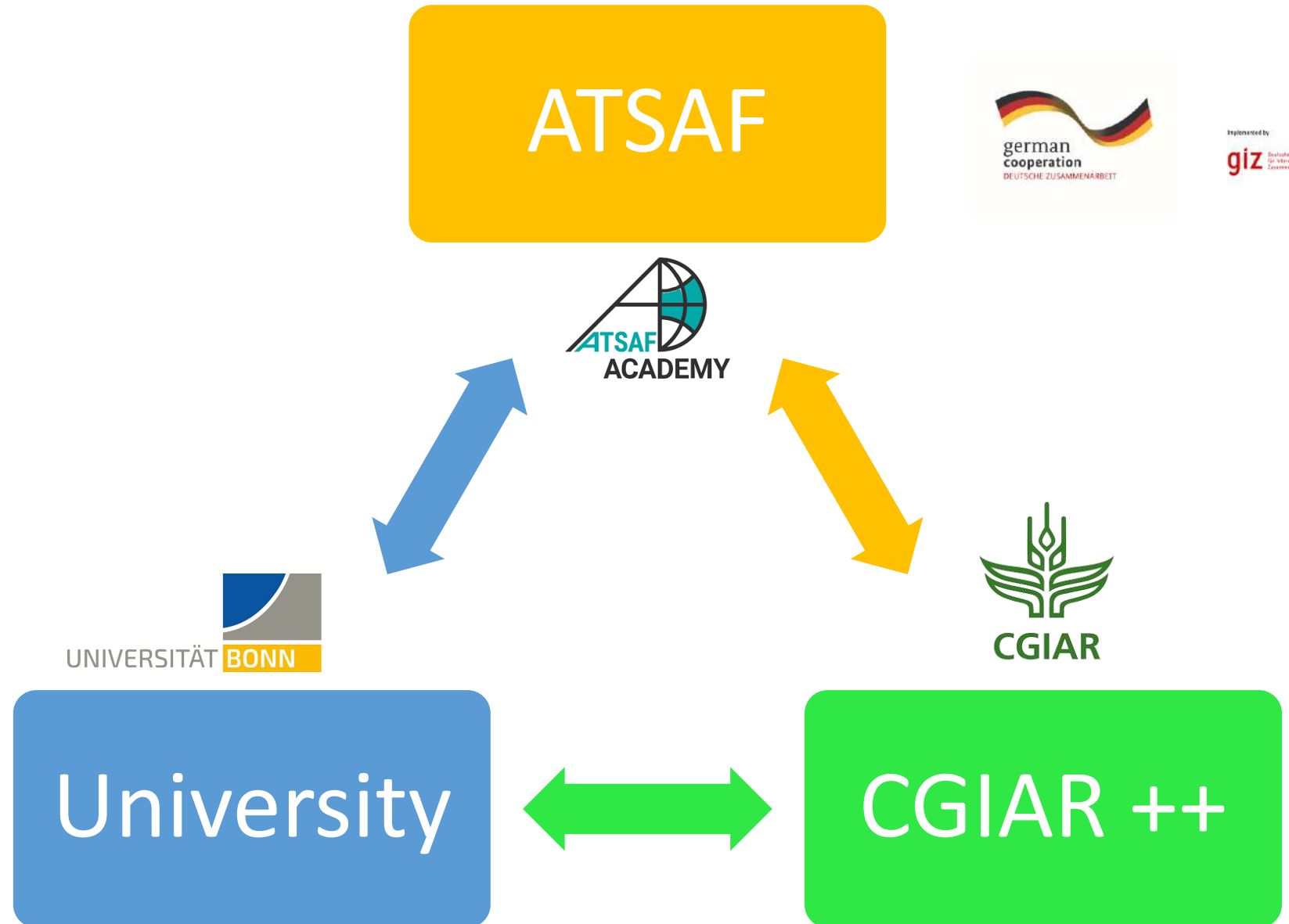
My journey so far



ATSAF scholarship

A PhD Research Scholarship of EUR 1,500 per month for a period of 3 years (with the possibility for a 12-month extension) and a research grant of up to EUR 25,000.

A MSc Career Exploration Scholarship (JST-Junior Scientists Tandems), where ATSAF financially supports MSc students over a period of 6 months with up to EUR 7,000.

What is funded?

- Depending on academic level, monthly payments of 861 euros for graduates or 1,200 euros for doctoral candidates
- Payments towards health, accident and personal liability insurance cover
- Travel allowance, unless these expenses are covered by the home country or another source of funding
- Under certain circumstances, scholarship holders may receive the following additional benefits:
 - Monthly rent subsidy
- Monthly allowance for accompanying members of family

What is EMJMD?

EMJMD is a prestigious integrated international study program delivered by consortium of higher education institutions in Europe and across the globe.

European Union (EU) provides funding for both running these programs and offering competitive scholarships to the best students worldwide.

The participants are allowed to pursue their masters and their mobility in minimum two different universities in different countries.

Scholarship available for 163 subjects in 12 areas: Chemistry, Economic Sciences, Environmental & Geosciences, History, Information Science & Engineering, Information Technology, Law, Life Sciences, Literature, Mathematics, Physics and Social Sciences & Humanities.

NETAJI SUBHAS - ICAR INTERNATIONAL FELLOWSHIPS

- A flagship program of ICAR.
- Every year (?) **30 positions will be advertised**. Selection is competitive.
- Out of 30, usually 20 are for the Indians who wants to pursue PhD abroad and 10 are for the foreign students who wish to study in India.
- Usually **advertised during June-July**, with a deadline for submitting complete application by 30 Aug/ Sept.
- Keep an eye on **ICAR website** for more information.

Eligibility

- Masters in Agriculture and allied subjects.
- OGPA > 6.60
- Age < 35
- In service candidate should be employed in ICAR- AU system. If fresh candidate, date of qualifying exam should not be before 2 years at the time of application.
- The proposal should address a priority area of research identified by council.

Application process

- Complete **application** (with two **references**) + Research **proposal** + **Letter of support** from prospective university supervisor + supporting documents.
- Research proposal should be in line with priority areas.
- Candidates will be shortlisted based on evaluation criteria (OGPA, awards, publications etc) and proposal.
- Shortlisted candidates will be **interviewed by a panel of experts** – Candidate should make a **short presentation**.
- Preparing a proposal and getting a letter of support after the advertisement is difficult – **Start early!**

After selection

- Each candidate has to provide a **bank guarantee equivalent to 10000 USD**. (Deposit the equivalent amount of money in bank and obtain Bank Guarantee(BG) on a bond paper).
- Submit the BG and the medical certificate to the council.
- Coordinate with your professor and university to finalise the travelling and joining date.
- **ICAR will book the flight tickets to the place of study.**
- **Monthly fellowship is equivalent to 2000 USD** – Remember this is gross amount.
- 1000 USD per year as contingency.
- **Only for a period of 3 years.**
